District No. 1-PCD, M.E.B.A. Officers' Election 2020 Elected Officials & Delegate Positions Open to Nomination



Consistent with the provisions of the District No. 1-PCD, M.E.B.A. By-Laws, Branch Offices will be maintained in the following ports: New York, Norfolk, Houston, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Seattle and Tampa. The By-Laws provide that Branch Agents and Headquarters Officers shall be ex-officio Delegates to National Conventions. Eleven additional Delegates to the National M.E.B.A. Convention (for a total of twenty Delegates, including ex-officio Delegates) will appear on the ballot in the referendum election of 2020 of District No. 1-PCD, M.E.B.A.

The following offices for election shall appear on the ballot in the 2020 District No. 1-PCD, M.E.B.A. referendum election:

The Impartial Administrator: The determination of the depository to which the ballots are to be mailed or delivered as well as an Impartial Administrator to oversee the balloting process of the 2020 District No. 1-PCD, M.E.B.A. election of Officers, Branch Agents, Patrolman and Delegates shall be determined at a later date, in accordance with the By-Laws.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING NOMINATIONS



This is a general explanation that does not change or otherwise interpret *M.E.B.A.* governing documents.

In accordance with M.E.B.A. governing documents, the period during which nominations for elected office may be submitted begins on June 8, 2020 and ends on July 10, 2020. Only nominations received during this period will be accepted and put before an elected rank and file Credentials Committee for qualification review. Ballots will be mailed to all members on Tuesday, September 1, 2020. Ballots must be returned to the designated depository by November 30, 2020. Ballot tabulation will take place on December 7, 2020. Candidates are advised to refer to the M.E.B.A. By-Laws and Constitution when submitting their nomination. Any member may submit his or her name for nomination for a District office, job, or additional Convention Delegate by delivery in person, courier or any such service that provides a certified time of receipt to both parties (including e-mail to mebahq@mebaunion.org). The letter or nomination form should be addressed to the Credentials Committee, c/o the District President, District No. 1-PCD, M.E.B.A., 444 North Capitol Street, NW, Suite 800, Washington, DC 20001-1570. The letter or form shall be dated and contain the following information:

- 1. The full name of the candidate and, if he/she wishes, any special name to appear on the ballot.
- 2. His/her home address and mailing address.
- 3. A copy of his/her last dues receipt or proof of dues check-off.
- 4. The title of the office or other job for which he/she is a candidate, including the name of the Branch in the event the position sought is that of Branch Agent or Patrolman.
- 5. Evidence of employment time for appropriate years in the form of copies of Coast Guard discharges, vacation vouchers, pay vouchers, employment history from Plans, or communications from employers. Attendance at the Calhoon M.E.B.A. Engineering School or any other school or educational program as a student is not qualifying employment for nomination.
- 6. The letter must also have attached to it a certificate in the following form signed and dated by the proposed nominee:

I hereby certify that I am not now, nor for the five (5) years last past, have I been either a member of the Communist Party or convicted of, or served any part of a

prison term resulting from conviction of robbery, bribery, extortion, embezzlement, grand larceny, burglary, arson, violation of narcotics laws, murder, rape, assault with intent to kill, assault which inflicts grievous bodily injury, or violation of title II or III of the Landrum-Griffin Act, or conspiracy to commit any such crimes.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMITTING NOMINATION FORMS

A 2020 Election Nomination Form as well as a listing of offices and positions available for nomination are included in this APB. Both have been made available to all M.E.B.A. Union halls and offices and can be found on the M.E.B.A. website on the "Documents & Member Notices" page (M.E.B.A. HQ & Union Hall Operational Notices).

A member is eligible for nomination to and election as a full-time and paid elective official provided he or she is at the time of nomination and election a member in good standing and [1] has been a member of the National Marine Engineers' Beneficial Association or of an organization which has duly affiliated with the National Marine Engineers' Beneficial Association and District No. 1-PCD, M.E.B.A. for one year immediately preceding the date of closing of nominations; [2] has either 180 days of employment, including days of vacation, employed with a company in a job covered by a collective bargaining agreement with the Union during each of any two full calendar years of the three calendar years immediately preceding the closing date of nominations or equal time served as a full-time and paid elected or appointed official of the National Association or District No. 1-PCD, M.E.B.A. or any organization which has duly affiliated with the National Association or equal time served in the employ or on behalf of one or more of any District's Plans. Eligibility will be determined by the Credentials Committee in July 2020.
