



The Union Advantage



Union members earn better wages and benefits than non-union workers. Unions help employers create a more stable, productive workforce—where workers have a say in improving their jobs. Unions also provide a voice on the job.

Workers in a union have:

- *higher wages (11.2% more than what non-union workers make)*
- *health insurance (96% compared to 69%)*
- *access to paid sick days (93% compared to 75%);*
- *retirement benefits (82% to 48%); and*
- *guaranteed pensions (54% to 8%).*

One of the prime benefits of M.E.B.A. membership is access to the M.E.B.A. Plans, one of the most comprehensive, well-funded and well-managed benefit plans in the unionized world.
